

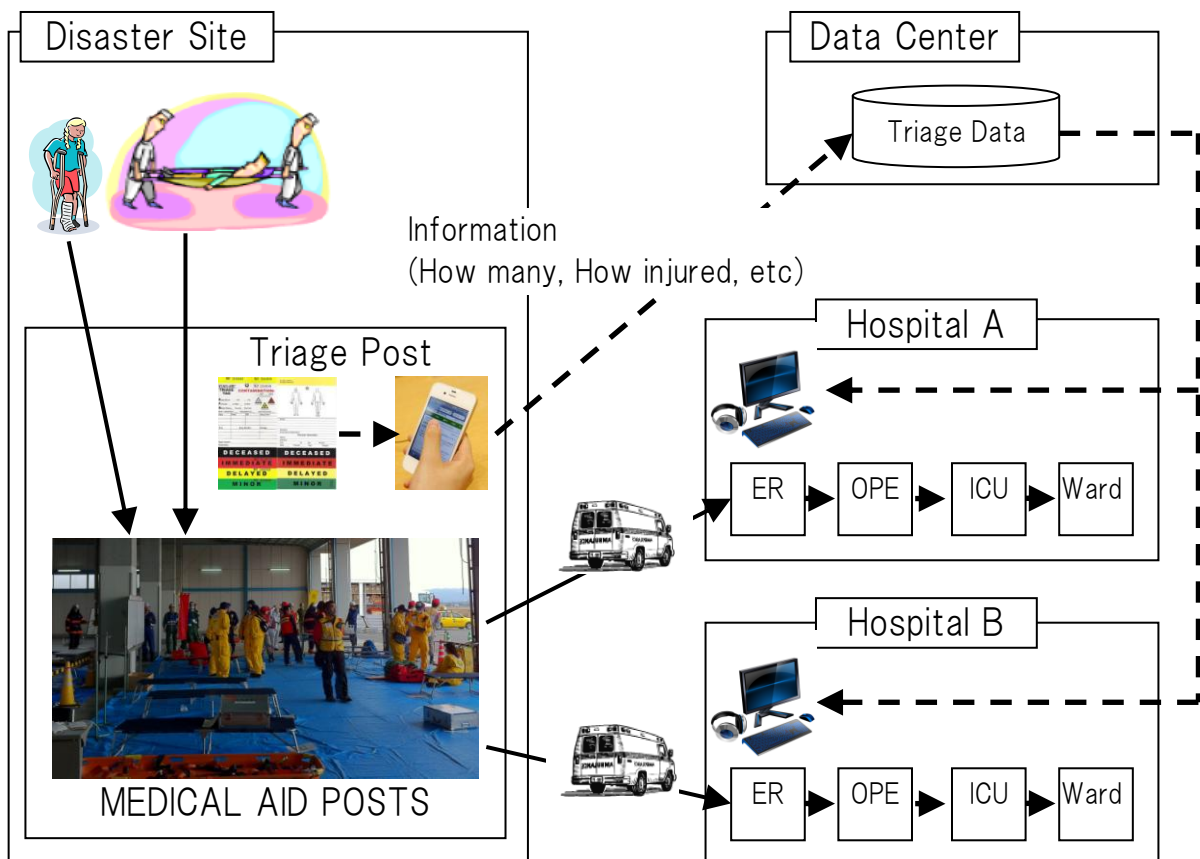
Triage Data Sharing System



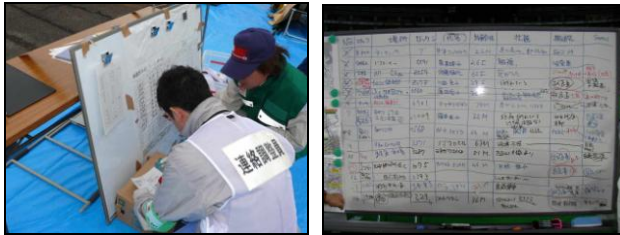
The key to disaster medicine ‘CSCATTT’

Command, Safety, Communication, Assessment, Triage, Treatment, Transport

‘Triage Data Sharing System’ provides a method to share Triage data on the internet. This is one Communication tool for disaster medicine.



Whiteboard



At a disaster site, a whiteboard is often used to track the status of victims.

However, using a whiteboard, the list may be delayed or outdated.

Triage Data Sharing System



By using the Triage Data Sharing System, you can enter the triage data and see the overall disaster situation at a glance.

In addition, accurate information can be shared from anywhere.

‘Triage Data Sharing System’ can be operated on PCs, tablet computers and smart phones like iPhone with browsers. With the above described mobile devices, you can input data which has similar style to the ones used in Triage Tag. The inputted data is immediately sent to the data center via the internet.

By accessing the data center, you can find triage data on the site and the situation of transporting patients before their arrival at your hospital’s door.

Triage Data Sharing System also does the listing up of names and adding up of the numbers of casualties. This information will be useful for facilities like Disaster Relief Headquarters etc.
